Now what do we do? Harvest is over and the equipment is put away for another season, inputs are ordered for next year and all of the data recorded on your display from last season has been unloaded and analyzed. Through this portal, whether you use a JDLink telematics option or manually load data to this portal it puts it into a format that is now able to be shared to many of your other trusted advisors for your farming operation. The data from the Operations Center can be setup to be automatically available to a partner (trusted advisor) that you choose or can manually be sent by individual files to separate trusted advisors. One other advantage of the Operation Center for machines that are equipped with the JDLink telematics option is the ability to have a backup copy of the data being recorded at the completion of each field.
